Sociminds - is an online student community I helped bring to life—designed to foster meaningful interaction, learning, and collaboration among peers

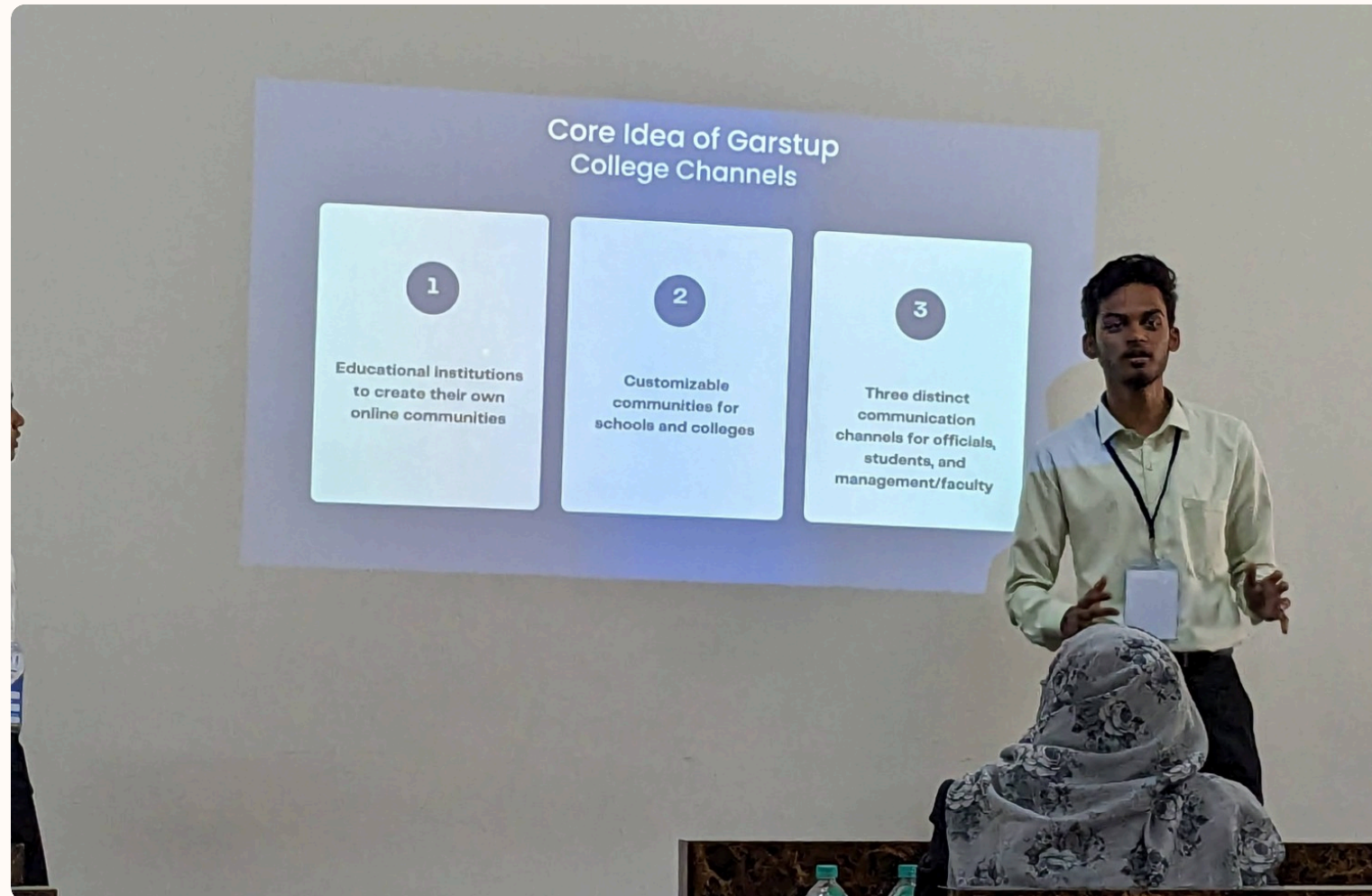

Suddenly love whiteboards more than coffee



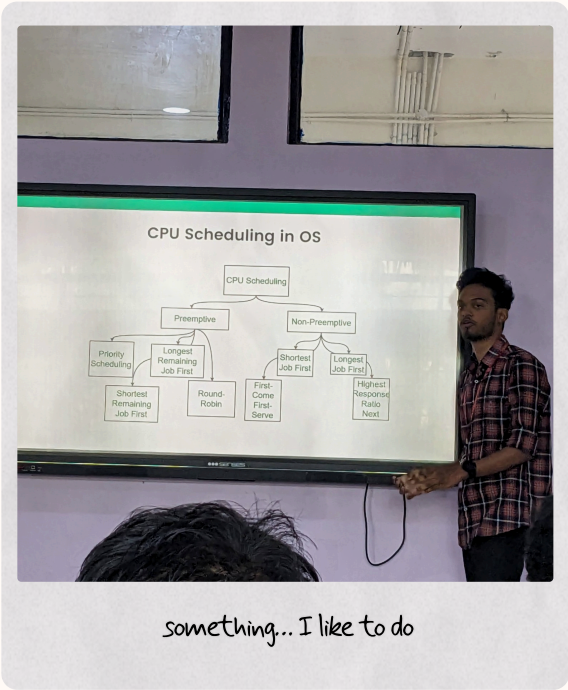
Keep naming products in your sleep
